1 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: 4 Advice and consent; financial disclosure. (a) Any person nominated and, by and with the advice and consent of 5 the senate, appointed by the governor shall submit a financial 6 7 disclosure statement to the governor and the senate president as 8 part of the advice and consent procedures of the senate. 9 The information on the financial disclosure statement (b) 10 shall be subject to the provisions of section 84-17, and shall 11 be confidential, except as provided in section 84-17(d)." 12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012. 14 Der Skan
