### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REAPPORTIONMENT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 25-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

amended to read as follows:

"\$25-2 Duties. (a) Legislative reapportionment. The

commission shall reapportion the members of each house of the

legislature on the basis, method, and criteria prescribed by the

Constitution of the United States and article IV of the Hawaii

Constitution. Pursuant thereto, the commission shall conduct

public hearings and consult with the apportionment advisory

9 council of each basic island unit. Not more than one hundred

days from the date on which all members are certified, the

11 commission shall cause to be given in each basic island unit,

12 public notice of a legislative reapportionment plan prepared and

proposed by the commission. At least one public hearing on the

proposed reapportionment plan shall be held in each basic island

15 unit after initial public notice of the plan. At least twenty

16 days' notice shall be given of the public hearing. The notice

17 shall include a statement of the substance of the proposed

reapportionment plan, and of the date, time, and place where



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- 1 interested persons may be heard thereon. The notice shall be
- 2 given at least once in the basic island unit where the hearing
- 3 will be held. All interested persons shall be afforded an
- 4 opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, orally or in
- 5 writing, for consideration by the commission. After the last of
- 6 the public hearings, [but in no event] which shall be held no
- 7 later than one hundred fifty days from the date on which all
- 8 members of the commission are certified, the commission shall
- 9 determine whether or not the plan is in need of correction or
- 10 modification, make the correction or modification, if any, and
- 11 file with the chief election officer, a final legislative
- 12 reapportionment plan[-] no later than one hundred eighty days
- from the date on which the commission members are certified.
- 14 Within fourteen days after the filing of the final
- 15 reapportionment plan, the chief election officer shall cause
- 16 public notice to be given of the final legislative
- 17 reapportionment plan which, upon public notice, shall become
- 18 effective as of the date of filing and govern the election of
- 19 members of the next five succeeding legislatures.
- 20 (b) Congressional reapportionment. At times that may be
- 21 required by the Constitution and that may be required by law of
- 22 the United States, the commission shall redraw congressional

- 9 state legislature and the reapportionment plan for the United
- 10 States congressional districts from one hundred fifty days to
- 11 one hundred eighty days from the date on which the
- 12 reapportionment commission members are certified.
