A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FUNDRAISING WHILE THE LEGISLATURE IS IN SESSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the public
- 2 perception that lawmaking is influenced by a legislator's
- 3 campaign fundraising should be addressed and eliminated. During
- 4 the legislative session, many individuals, businesses, and other
- 5 groups seek favorable action from legislators on measures
- 6 introduced and heard throughout the session. When legislators
- 7 solicit campaign donations from similar stakeholders while
- 8 legislation is pending, the public has reason to mistrust the
- 9 lawmaking process. As a result, the public becomes suspicious
- 10 that legislative votes may be affected by fundraising activity.
- 11 Even if the legislators' motives are pure, public perception of
- 12 the legislature and the lawmaking process is lowered, along with
- 13 the public trust and confidence in elected officials.
- 14 The legislature believes that banning fundraisers during
- 15 regular sessions of the legislature will reduce public suspicion
- 16 and result in increased public trust and confidence in our
- 17 elected leaders.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit fundraising activity
- 2 of legislators during regular sessions of the legislature.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 11-342, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 "[+] §11-342[+] [Fundraiser; notice of intent.]
- 6 Fundraisers. (a) No fundraiser shall be held unless a notice
- 7 of intent to hold the fundraiser is filed with the commission
- 8 setting forth the name and address of the person in charge, the
- 9 price per person, the date, hour, and place of the fundraiser,
- 10 and the method thereof.
- 11 (b) The person in charge of the fundraiser shall file the
- 12 notice with the commission prior to the fundraiser.
- (c) No fundraiser shall be held by any candidate for
- 14 public office who also holds a seat in the state legislature
- 15 during the period in which the legislature is in regular
- 16 session.
- 17 [(c)] (d) As used in this section, "fundraiser" means any
- 18 function held for the benefit of a candidate, candidate
- 19 committee, or noncandidate committee that is intended or
- 20 designed, directly or indirectly, to raise contributions for
- 21 which the price or suggested contribution for attending the
- 22 function is more than \$25 per person."



- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012, or
- 4 upon its approval, whichever is later.
