A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MANAGEMENT OF STATE FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows: 3 By amending subsection (b) to read: 4 Not later than January 1, [2009,] 2013, the 5 department of budget and finance, in accordance with this section, shall establish, implement, and maintain a single 6 searchable website, accessible by the public at no cost, that 7 8 includes for each state award: 9 The name of the entity receiving the award; (1) 10 (2) The amount of the award; 11 (3) Information on the award, including transaction type, 12 funding agency, program source, and an award title descriptive of the purpose of each funding action; 13 14 (4)The full address of the entity receiving the award and 15 the primary location of performance under the award; 16 (5) A unique identifier of the entity receiving the award 17 and of the parent entity of the recipient, if the 18 entity is owned by another entity; and

- 1 (6) Any other relevant information specified by the
- department of budget and finance.
- 3 The website shall include data for fiscal year [2008] 2012
- 4 and each fiscal year thereafter.
- 5 The director of finance is authorized to designate one or
- 6 more state agencies to participate in the development,
- 7 establishment, maintenance, and support of the website; provided
- 8 that the department of accounting and general services, in
- 9 collaboration with the department of budget and finance, is
- 10 responsible for collecting and posting on the website, the
- 11 information that is required by this subsection. In the initial
- 12 designation, or in subsequent instructions and guidance, the
- 13 director may specify the scope of the responsibilities of each
- 14 agency.
- 15 State agencies shall comply with the instructions and
- 16 guidance issued by the director of finance and shall provide
- 17 appropriate assistance to the director upon request, so as to
- 18 assist the director in ensuring the existence and operation of
- 19 the website."
