A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOMELESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many homeless
- 2 persons are known to thrive when they have ready access to
- 3 familiar support groups or family members. The intent of the
- 4 return-to-home program is to ensure that those individuals who
- 5 find themselves homeless are able to reconnect with support
- 6 networks that are ready and able to receive them.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to establish a return-to-home
- 8 program for qualified homeless individuals.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to part XVII to be appropriately
- 11 designated and to read as follows:
- 12 "S346- Return-to-home program. (a) There may be
- 13 established within the department, a voluntary homeless
- 14 assistance program to be known as the return-to-home program, to
- 15 assist eligible homeless individuals to reunite with family and
- 16 relatives in the individual's home state. The department shall
- 17 administer the program.

1	(b)	A homeless individual shall not be eligible to
2	participa	te in the program unless:
3	(1)	The individual's participation is completely
4		voluntary;
5	(2)	The individual has a support system in place in the
6		individual's home state that is willing to receive and
7		accommodate the individual;
8	<u>(3)</u>	The individual, if on parole, probation, or awaiting a
9		court hearing or sentencing, has proper clearance from
10		the court to participate in the program; and
11	(4)	The individual is indigent and lacks the financial
12		resources necessary to secure transportation to return
13		to the individual's home state.
14	<u>(c)</u>	An individual may participate in the return-to-home
15	program o	nly once and shall sign an agreement to this effect
16	prior to	participating in the program. The agreement shall be
17	kept on f	ile with the department.
18	<u>(d)</u>	The department shall actively seek the participation
19	of local	airlines, cruise lines, charter companies, homeless
20	programs,	travel agencies, and the visitor industry to
21	coordinat	e and implement the program.
22	<u>(e)</u>	The department shall:

1	<u>(1)</u>	Assist program participants with necessary and proper
2		preparations for the return trip, including obtaining
3		proper identification, public transportation to the
4		airport, aid with orientation relating to airport
5		security, and the basics of personal hygiene;
6	(2)	Ensure that the participant has sufficient physical
7		and mental health to endure a return flight; and
8	<u>(3)</u>	Follow up with each individual within one month of the
9		individual's return to the individual's home state to
10		assess efforts at successful reunification with any
11		family or support system.
12	<u>(f)</u>	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
13	91 to develop the return-to-home program and adopt standards for	
14	its implementation."	
15	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general	
16	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much	
17	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to	
18	implement the return-to-home program, including all program	
19	costs and the hiring of necessary staff.	
20	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of	
21	human ser	vices for the purposes of this Act.
