- 7 celebrating Children and Youth Day shall be held on the grounds
- 8 of the state capitol on the first Sunday in October, if the
- Children and Youth Day planning committee so chooses, unless 9
- otherwise determined by the governor. This day and month are 10
- 11 not and shall not be construed to be state holidays."
- 12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 13
