## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOMELESS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The homeless programs office of the
- 2 department of human services shall establish designated safe
- 3 areas in various locations throughout the State for homeless
- 4 persons to reside until permanent housing becomes available.
- 5 The designated safe areas shall provide clean eating areas,
- 6 showers, toilets, and laundry facilities.
- 7 (b) The homeless programs office shall establish rules and
- 8 a code of conduct for individuals, couples, and families
- 9 residing in the designated safe areas. The office shall have
- 10 the authority to take appropriate action should a homeless
- 11 individual, couple, or family not comply with the rules or
- 12 participate in any illegal activity while residing in the
- 13 designated safe areas. The office may establish a minimum fee
- 14 to live in the designated safe areas; provided that any fees
- 15 collected shall be used to offset expenses associated with the
- 16 establishment and maintenance of the designated safe areas.
- 17 (c) The homeless programs office shall partner with
- 18 community and nonprofit organizations in good standing with the

- 1 State to provide homeless support services for homeless persons
- 2 who reside in the designated safe areas. The office shall
- 3 coordinate with state and county law enforcement officials to
- 4 establish minimal security for the safety of individuals in the
- 5 designated safe areas.
- 6 (d) The department of human services shall adopt rules
- 7 pursuant to chapter 91 for purposes of implementing this Act.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Homeless; Homeless Programs Office; Designated Safe Areas; Keiki Caucus

### Description:
