### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVERTISING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 328J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§328J- Sale and advertising of tobacco products in 5 retail establishments. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no tobacco or advertisements for tobacco shall be 6 7 located within a five-foot radius of a point-of-sale within a 8 retail establishment. 9 (b) For purposes of this section: 10 "Point-of-sale" means the physical location within a retail 11 establishment where the sale of goods to customers is 12 transacted. "Retail establishment" means a retail store that sells 13 14 tobacco." 15 SECTION 2. Section 281-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

"(e) Class 4. Retail dealer license.

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1	<u>(1)</u>	A license to sell liquor at retail or to class 10
2		licensees shall authorize the licensee to sell the
3		liquor therein specified in their original packages.
4		Under a class 4 license, no liquor shall be consumed
5		on the premises except as authorized by the
6		commission. Of this class, there shall be the
7		following kinds:
8	[ <del>(1)</del> ]	(A) General (includes all liquor except alcohol);
9	[ <del>(2)</del> ]	(B) Beer and wine; and
10	[ <del>(3)</del> ]	(C) Alcohol.
11	(2)	It shall be unlawful for a class 4 licensee to display
12		or locate any alcohol within a five-foot radius of a
13		point-of-sale within the licensed premises.
14	(3)	For purposes of paragraph (2), "point-of-sale" means
15		the physical location within the licensed premises
16		where the sale of goods to customers is transacted."
17	SECTI	ON 3. Section 281-44, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18	amended to	read as follows:
19	"§281	-44 Advertisements and signs upon licensed premises.
20	(a) All l	icensed premises shall post a sign in or about the
21	premises o	containing and notifying all customers and other
22	persons of	the possible sanctions that may be imposed for
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- 1 operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant under
- 2 sections 291E-41 and 291E-61. The sign shall be conspicuously
- 3 positioned in order to be seen by an ordinarily observant
- 4 person.
- 5 (b) The liquor commission may prescribe the character and
- 6 extent of all other advertisements, posters, or signs which may
- 7 be posted or maintained in or about the licensed premises [-];
- 8 provided that no advertisements, posters, or signs for alcohol
- 9 shall be located within a five-foot radius of a point-of-sale
- 10 within the licensed premises of a class 4 licensee.
- (c) For purposes of subsection (b), "point-of-sale" means
- 12 the physical location within the licensed premises where the
- 13 sale of goods to customers is transacted."
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.
- 17 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
