(1) A person commits the offense of 4 5 impersonating a law enforcement officer in the first degree if, 6 with intent to deceive, the person pretends to be a law 7 enforcement officer, and [is armed with a firearm.]: 8 is armed with a firearm; (a) 9 (b) intentionally or knowingly causes another person to 10 apprehend a harmful or offensive contact; threatens violence to another person by an immediate 11 (c) 12 show of force; 13 (d) threatens or attempts to confiscate or damage property 14 of another person; or, 15 threatens or attempts to exercise dominion or control 16 over another person.
