BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 25-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$25-3 Powers. The commission may require all such 4 persons as it deems necessary to appear personally and testify before it and to produce to it all books, records, files, 5 papers, maps and documents as shall appear to be necessary for 6 the purpose of formulating a reapportionment plan. 7 8 chairperson of the commission or any member thereof acting on 9 behalf of the chairperson shall have power to administer oaths to persons summoned to appear before the commission and such **10** 11 persons may be questioned, under oath, concerning all matters necessary for the due execution of the duties vested in the 12 13 commission by the Constitution and by this chapter. 14 hearings and proceedings shall be governed by this chapter and 15 by rules of practice and procedure established by the 16 commission.] A majority of its membership shall constitute a quorum to do business, and the concurrence of a majority of its 17 membership shall be necessary to make any action of the 18

1 commission valid. Meetings shall be called and held at the call 2 of the chairperson or by a quorum. All proceedings of the 3 commission, commission committees, and apportionment advisory 4 councils that concern official commission business shall be open 5 to the public, except for proceedings held for the sole purpose 6 of selecting administrative staff or contractors' services. All 7 meetings, hearings and proceedings shall be governed by this 8 chapter and by rules of practice and procedure established by 9 the commission." 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 11 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
