A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1124, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 3 "§302A-1124 Mandate to initiate school community councils. 4 (a) The department, through the board and its superintendent, shall establish a school community council system under which 5 6 each public school, excluding charter schools, shall create and 7 maintain a school community council. Each school community council shall: 8 Review and evaluate the school's academic plan and 9 (1)financial plan, and either recommend revisions of the 10 11 plans to the principal, or recommend the plans for approval by the complex area superintendent; 12 Ensure that the school's academic and financial plans 13 (2) 14 are consistent with the educational accountability 15 system under section 302A-1004;
- 16 (3) Submit all recommendations in writing based on
 17 findings that are detailed and specific, and at a

3	[(3)]	(4) Participate in principal selection and
4		evaluation, and transmit any such evaluations to the

9		community meetings annually in each school community,
10		in addition to their regular meetings, for the purpose

- 1 at a minimum state why the proposal is contrary to the best
- 2 interests of the school. If the school community council opposes
- 3 a decision of the principal, an appeal shall first be brought to
- 4 the complex area superintendent for resolution and, if
- 5 necessary, to the superintendent and, finally, to the board of
- 6 education."

- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
