A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KAHOOLAWE ISLAND RESERVE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 6K-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§6K-5 Commission. (a) There is established the 4 Kaho'olawe island reserve commission to be placed within the 5 department of land and natural resources for administrative purposes as provided in section 26-35. The commission shall 6 7 consist of seven members to be appointed in the manner and to 8 serve for the terms provided in section 26-34[+], except as provided in subsection (e); provided that: 9 10 (1)One member shall be [a member of] appointed by the 11 governor from a list provided by the Protect Kaho'olawe 12 Ohana; 13 (2) [Two] Three members shall be appointed by the governor 14 from a list provided by [the Protect Kaho'olawe Ohana;] 15 native Hawaiian organizations; 16 (3) One member shall be a trustee or representative of the 17 office of Hawaiian affairs;

1	(4)	One member shall be a county official appointed by the
2		governor from a list provided by the mayor of the

8	(b)	The governor shall appoint the chairperson from among

14	(d)	Any action taken by the commission shall be approved
15	by a simp	le majority of its members. [Four] Three members shall
16	constitute	e a quorum to do business.
17	<u>(e)</u>	Notwithstanding section 26-34, any person appointed to
18	the commis	ssion pursuant to subsection (a) who has completed two

consecutive terms as a member of the commission shall not be eligible to be appointed to the commission for a period of four years commencing the last day of the second consecutive term of the person's service as a member of the commission; provided 2012-0446 SB SMA.doc

Report Title:

Kahoolawe Island Reserve Commission; Membership; Quorum

Description:

Amends the Kahoolawe island reserve commission membership by no longer requiring a member to also be a Protect Kahoolawe Ohana. Reduces the number of members to be appointed by the governor from a list provided by Protect Kahoolawe Ohana. Increases the number of members to be appointed by the governor from a list provided by native Hawaiian organizations to three. Changes the commission quorum requirement. Mandates a 4-year wait for reappointment to the commission for any member who has completed two consecutive terms.

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
