A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRISON LITIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 661, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

 and to read as follows:

 Exhaustion of administrative remedies; action by
- 5 prisoners, when limited. (a) No action shall be brought in any
- 6 state court with respect to prison conditions, under any state
- 7 or federal law, by a prisoner confined in any jail, prison, or
- 8 other correctional facility until available administrative
- 9 remedies are exhausted within sixty days from the filing of a
- 10 complaint by the prisoner.
- 11 (b) As used in this section, the term "prisoner" means any
- 12 person incarcerated or detained in any facility who is accused
- 13 of, convicted of, or sentenced for violations of criminal law or
- 14 the terms and conditions of parole, probation, pretrial release,
- 15 or diversionary program. The term does not apply to juveniles
- 16 incarcerated in youth correctional facilities."
- 17 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
