18	SECTION 3. The sums hereinabove may be paid to the			
19	respective persons, or for the satisfaction or settlement of the			
20	respectively identified cases, and in several amounts			
21	hereinabove set forth or in lesser amounts deemed appropriate,			
22	upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided departments			
23	shall obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment			
24	of any claim can be made.			
25	SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as			
26	interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest			
27	shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if			
28	applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,			

- 1 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
- 2 cases to which the statute applies.
- 3 SECTION 5. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 4 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 5 June 30, 2013, shall lapse.
- 6 SECTION 6. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 7 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 8 invalid, the invalidity does not effect other provisions or
- 9 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 10 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 11 of this Act are severable.
- 12 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
