## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 290, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997,
- 2 established incentives for registration, licensing, parking, and
- 3 operation of electric vehicles. Although the provisions
- 4 relating to vehicle licensing and parking are valid laws of
- 5 Hawaii, it is difficult to find and reference them, because they
- 6 are only contained in the session laws, which are not as readily
- 7 available to the public as are the Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 8 which are available online.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to enable the public to more
- 10 readily access the existing laws pertaining to electric vehicles
- 11 by codifying elements of Act 290, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997,
- 12 into the Hawaii Revised Statutes and providing amendments for
- 13 clarity, consistency, and enforceability.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 16 and to read as follows:
- 17 "S286- Electric vehicles; registration; license
- 18 plates; parking fee exemptions. (a) The department of

4	(b)	An electric vehicle on which an electric vehicle
5	license p	late is affixed shall be exempt from payment of parking
6	fees, inc	luding those collected through parking meters, charged
7	by any st	ate or county authority in this State, except that this
8	exemption	shall not apply:
9	(1)	For more than two and one-half hours of metered
10		parking, or the maximum amount of time the meter
11		allows, whichever is longer; or
12	(2)	To parking fees assessed in increments longer than one
13		twenty-four-hour day, including weekly, monthly, or
14		annual parking permits.
15	<u>(c)</u>	An electric vehicle on which an electric vehicle
16	license p	late is affixed shall be exempt from high occupancy
17	vehicle 1	ane restrictions.
18	(d)	For the purposes of this section:
19	<u>"Ele</u>	ctric vehicle" means:
20	(1)	A neighborhood electric vehicle; or
21	(2)	A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
22		propulsion energy from a battery with at least four

1	kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
2	recharged from an external source of electricity."
3	SECTION 3. Act 290, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997, is
4	repealed.
5	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 5 This Act shall take effect upon its approval

## Report Title:

Electric Vehicles

## Description:

Codifies certain provisions of Act 290, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997, and repeals the rest. Authorizes the Department of Transportation to adopt rules for the registration of, and issuance of license plates for electric vehicles. Exempts electric vehicles from parking fees under certain conditions. (SB2746 HD2)
