A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 207, Hawaiian Homes Commission Act,
- 2 1920, as amended, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 "(b) The title to lands so leased shall remain in the
- 5 State. Applications for tracts shall be made to and granted by
- 6 the department, under such regulations, not in conflict with any
- 7 provisions of this title, as the department may prescribe.
- 8 Notwithstanding any rule to the contrary, the chairperson of the
- 9 Hawaiian homes commission, with unanimous consent from the
- 10 commission, may award a lease to any native Hawaiian with an
- 11 original application date of not less than twenty years from the
- 12 date of the approval. The department shall, whenever tracts are
- 13 available, enter into such a lease with any applicant who, in
- 14 the opinion of the department, is qualified to perform the
- 15 conditions of such lease."
- 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050;
- provided that this Act shall be repealed on June 30, 2017, and 2012-1459 SB2793 SD2 SMA.doc
