## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 356D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) If a vacancy occurs for the resident member seat on the board, the resident advisory board shall compile a list of 4 5 no less than three but no more than five individuals for the 6 governor's consideration for appointment to the board; provided 7 that the nominees to the board shall be: 8 (1)Participants who are directly assisted by the 9 authority under the federal public housing or section **10** 8 tenant-based programs and who need not be members of the resident advisory board; 11 12 (2) At least eighteen years of age; and (3) Authorized members of the assisted household." 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 15
