4	used by the department to support the continuing development and
5	operation of a comprehensive state trauma system. The trauma
6	system special fund shall be used to subsidize the documented
7	costs for the comprehensive state trauma system, including but
8	not limited to the following:
9	(1) Costs of under-compensated and uncompensated trauma
10	care incurred by hospitals providing care to trauma
11	patients; [and]
12	(2) Costs incurred by hospitals providing care to trauma
13	patients to maintain on-call physicians for trauma
14	care[-]; and
15	(3) Costs to staff and operate the State's injury
16	prevention program.
17	The money in the trauma system special fund shall not be

18 used to supplant funding for trauma services authorized prior to SB2827 HD1 HMS 2012-3326



- 1 July 1, 2006, and shall not be used for ambulance or medical air
- 2 transport services."
