A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GROUNDED VESSELS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 200-47.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	" (b)	Solely for the purposes of removal and with no
4	liability	to the department, the department may assume control
5	of any ve	ssel that:
6	. (1)	Is grounded on a coral reef or in imminent danger of
7		breaking up; and
8	(2)	Cannot be immediately removed by the owner within
9		[seventy two] twenty-four hours of actual notification
10		to the vessel owner or the owner's representative by
11		the department and in a manner that is reasonably
12		safe, as determined by the department. <u>If the</u>
13		department has made good faith efforts to provide
14		actual notice to the owner or the owner's
15		representative but such actual notice is futile, the
16		department may assume control of the grounded vessel
17		within twenty-four hours from the time it has been
18		determined actual notice is futile. If the owner's

1	representative has received actual notice from the
2	department and has commenced effective salvage
3	operations, this section shall not apply.
4	The owner of the vessel may continue as the primary agent
5	in salvaging the vessel after twenty-four hours upon providing
6	proof of a marine insurance policy listing the State as an
7	additional insured in the amount of at least \$1,000,000 and
8	proof that the owner is actively and effectively initiating a
9	salvage effort with reasonable evidence, as determined by the
10	department, that the vessel may be saved within seventy-two
11	hours of grounding; provided that the department may allow an
12	extension beyond the seventy-two hour limit if it determines
13	that no additional environmental damage exists. Once the
14	department assumes control over the vessel, the vessel shall be
15	removed by conventional salvage methods to minimize damage to
16	the natural resources and not become a hazard to navigation.
17	All costs and expenses of removing the vessel and damage to
18	state or private property shall be the sole responsibility of
19	the vessel's owner or operator. This section shall apply
20	whether the vessel is attended or deemed derelict under section
21	200-48."

- 1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Grounded Vessels; Department of Land and Natural Resources; Salvage

Description:

Authorizes the Department of Land and Natural Resources to assume control of and remove a vessel grounded on a coral reef or in imminent danger of breaking apart if the vessel cannot be removed by the owner within twenty-four hours of actual notice to the vessel's owner of the grounding. Provides requirements to allow the owner of the vessel to continue an effort to salvage a grounded vessel beyond twenty-four hours under certain conditions and allows the department to grant more time to the owner to remove the vessel if no additional environmental damage exists. (SB2850 HD2)
