BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a	
2	gambling commission to perform a comprehensive analysis of the	
3	costs and benefits of various types of gambling to enable	
4	legislators to make informed decisions regarding gambling.	
5	SECT	ION 2. (a) There is established a gambling
6	commissio	n, which shall:
7	(1)	Analyze the financial and social costs and benefits of
8		various types of gambling activity, including but not
9		limited to the lottery, casino, slots, table games,
10		horse and dog racing, sports betting, bingo, and
11		internet gaming;
12	(2)	Assess the financial viability of each type of
13		gambling in the State; and
14	(3)	Determine what percentage of each dollar put into a
15		gambling system would likely be remitted for
16		administration, for prizes, to retailers, and to the
17		State.

- 1 (1) Three individuals selected by the governor;
- 2 (2) Three individuals selected by the senate president;

- 7 selection and terms of gaming commission members.
- 8 (c) The gambling commission shall be administratively

- 12 receive compensation for their service but shall be reimbursed

- 19 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 5 this Act.
- 6 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 7 provided that section 5 shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
