A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The stadium authority is directed to 2 transfer the development rights of the parcel of land identified
- 3 as tax map key to the public land development
- 4 corporation; provided that the stadium authority shall continue
- 5 to execute its responsibilities relating to negotiating or
- 6 executing a contract for any request for proposal or managing
- 7 any existing contract until the public land development
- $oldsymbol{8}$ corporation is able to assume the negotiating, oversight, and
- 9 management responsibilities relating to the existing contract or
- 10 request for proposal, as the case may be, or until June 30,
- 11 2013, whichever occurs first.
- 12 (b) The public land development corporation shall
- 13 coordinate the development of the land pursuant to chapter 171C,
- 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, notwithstanding any portion of the land
- 15 is private land.
- 16 SECTION 2. All deeds, leases, contracts, loans,
- 17 agreements, permits, or other documents executed or entered into
- 18 by or on behalf of the stadium authority pursuant to the SB2918 SD2 LRB 12-1910-1.doc



- 1 provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, applicable to
- 2 development rights of tax map key , are being
- 3 transferred pursuant to this Act and shall remain in full force
- 4 and effect, unless affirmatively amended by the appropriate
- 5 agency, under due process. Upon the effective date of this Act,
- 6 every reference to the stadium authority applicable to
- 7 development rights of tax map key , that are being
- 8 transferred pursuant to this Act shall be construed as a
- 9 reference to the public land development corporation.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
