## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AQUACULTURE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 171-59, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) Disposition of public lands for airline, aircraft,
4	airport-related, agricultural processing, cattle feed
5	production, aquaculture, marine, maritime, and maritime-related
6	operations may be negotiated without regard to the limitations
7	set forth in subsection (a) and section 171-16(c); provided
8	that:
9	(1) The disposition encourages competition within the
10	aeronautical, airport-related, agricultural,
11	aquaculture, maritime, and maritime-related
12	operations;
13	(2) The disposition shall not exceed a maximum term of
14	thirty-five years, except in the case of:
15	(A) Maritime and maritime-related operations, which
16	may provide for a maximum term of seventy years;

1	(B) [Aquaculture] Land-based aquaculture operations,
2	which may provide for a maximum term of sixty-
3	five years; provided that <a href="Land-based"><u>land-based</u></a> aquaculture
4	operations in good standing may seek to renew a
5	lease issued under this section and, during the
6	lease term, may engage in supportive activities
7	that are related to or integrated with
8	aquaculture; and
9	(3) The method of disposition of public lands for cattle
10	feed production as set forth in this subsection shall
11	not apply after December 31, 1988.
12	For the purposes of this subsection:
13	"Agricultural processing" means the processing of
14	agricultural products, including dairying, grown, raised, or
15	produced in Hawaii.
16	"Airport-related" means a purpose or activity that requires
17	air transportation to achieve that purpose or activity.
18	["Aquaculture"] "Land-based aquaculture" means the on-land
19	propagation, cultivation, or farming of aquatic plants and
20	animals in controlled or selected environments for research,
21	commercial, or stocking purposes, including aguaponics or any

- 1 growing of plants or animals with aquaculture effluents[-], and
- 2 does not include aquaculture conducted in the ocean.
- 3 "Maritime-related" means a purpose or activity that
- 4 requires and is directly related to the loading, off-loading,
- 5 storage, or distribution of goods and services of the maritime
- 6 industry."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
