A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that bone marrow
 2 transplantation services are not available in the State. This
 3 procedure is used to treat patients with leukemia, aplastic
- 4 anemia, lymphomas such as Hodgkin's disease, multiple myeloma,
- 5 immune deficiency disorders, and some solid tumors such as
- 6 breast and ovarian cancer.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to implement a new bone marrow
- 8 transplantation program in the State by appropriating funds as a
- 9 grant for Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children to
- 10 implement a peripheral blood stem cell/apheresis program.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 as a grant
- 14 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for Kapiolani
- 15 Medical Center for Women and Children to implement a peripheral
- 16 blood stem cell/apheresis program.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
