A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that bone marrow
- 2 transplantation services are not available in this State. This
- 3 procedure is used to treat patients with leukemia, aplastic
- 4 anemia, lymphomas such as Hodgkin's disease, multiple myeloma,
- 5 immune deficiency disorders, and some solid tumors such as
- 6 breast and ovarian cancer.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to the
- 8 department of health to implement a new bone marrow
- 9 transplantation program in the State.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the
- 13 implementation of a new bone marrow transplantation program in
- 14 the State.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
