A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many states allow
2	insurers to offer motor vehicle insurance discounts to drivers
3	who complete a driver safety course or driver improvement course
4	in the classroom or online. However, existing law in Hawaii on
5	discriminatory practices in underwriting is silent on allowing
6	motor vehicle insurance companies to offer discounts of any
7	kind.
8	The purpose of this Act is to allow motor vehicle insurance
9	companies to offer discounts on premiums if the insured
10	completes a driver safety or driver improvement course.
11	SECTION 2. Section 431:10C-207, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
12	is amended to read as follows:
13	"§431:10C-207 Discriminatory practices prohibited[-];
14	driver safety or improvement course. (a) [No] Except as
15	provided in subsection (b), no insurer shall base any standard
16.	or rating plan, in whole or in part, directly or indirectly,

upon a person's race, creed, ethnic extraction, age, sex, length

- 1 of driving experience, credit bureau rating, marital status, or
- 2 physical handicap.
- 3 (b) An insurer may offer premium discounts for drivers who
- 4 complete a driver safety course or driver improvement course."
- 5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
