BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 Section 312-3.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§312-3.8 [Hawaii state library foundation and friends of 4 the library of Hawaii concessions; use of public library 5 facilities.] Use of public library facilities; funds. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the head librarian of 6 7 each library branch in the Hawaii state public library system, 8 [through] with the approval of the state librarian, shall [be 9 authorized to issue licenses, revocable permits, concessions, 10 or rights of entry for the use of the facilities and grounds of 11 that library branch and for such periods of use as deemed 12 appropriate by the state librarian to [the Hawaii state library 13 foundation and the friends of the library of Hawaii for the use 14 of public library system facilities and grounds and for such 15 periods of use as deemed appropriate by the state librarian.] the Friends of the Library of Hawaii and any tax-exempt non-16 17 profit corporation recognized by the Internal Revenue Service 18 under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code whose

Requires the head librarian of each library branch in the Hawaii state public library system, with the approval of the state librarian, to issue licenses, revocable permits, concessions, or rights of entry for the use of facilities and grounds of that library branch to the Friends of the Library of Hawaii and any 501(c)(3) corporation that exists for the purpose of supporting a library within the Hawaii State Public Library System.
