# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE TIRES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that discarded motor SECTION 1. vehicle tires continue to blight Hawaii's neighborhoods, 2 particularly in rural and isolated areas. With the repeal of 3 the motor vehicle tire surcharge, the department of health lost 4 a vital source of funding to promote tire recovery and prevent 5 illegal dumping. Subsequent personnel and operating budget cuts 7 have made it difficult for the department to address this 8 critical issue. The purpose of this Act is to establish a task force to 9 study ways to prevent or control the problem of abandoned tires 10 11 littering the landscape. SECTION 2. (a) The director of health shall convene a 12 task force to study ways to prevent or control the problem of 13 14 abandoned tires littering the landscape.
- The task force shall be composed of: 15 (b)
- The director of health, or the director's designee; 16 (1)
- The chairperson of the board of land and natural 17 (2)
- resources, or the chairperson's designee; 18

20	(c)	The task force shall be administratively attached to

- (d) No member of the task force created by this measure 1 2 shall be made subject to chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of that member's participation on the task force. 3 SECTION 3. Members of the task force shall serve without 4 5 compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties. 6 SECTION 4. The task force shall report its findings and 7 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 8 9 legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of the regular session of 2014, and shall be dissolved on December 10
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
