A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING CREDITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 46-15.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:	
3	"(b)	Each county shall issue affordable housing credits to	
4	the depart	tment of Hawaiian home lands with respect to existing	
5	and future	e Hawaiian home lands projects upon a request for such	
6	credits by	y the department of Hawaiian home lands. Credits shall	
7	be issued	for each single-family residence, multi-family unit,	
8	other residential unit, or if allowed under the county's		
9	affordable	e housing programs, vacant lot, developed by the	
10	departmen	t of Hawaiian home lands as follows:	
11	(1)	All units or lots developed by the department shall be	
12		treated as for-sale units or lots;	
13	(2)	All units or lots developed by the department are	
14		deemed to be sold to purchasers with the highest	
15		income level that would qualify a unit or lot for	
16		credit under the county's affordable housing programs,	
17		unless the department provides verification of a	
18		<pre>purchaser's actual income;</pre>	

1	<u>(3)</u>	If the department does not provide verification of a
2		purchaser's actual income, the county shall issue at
3		least the number of credits corresponding to units
4		sold to purchasers with the highest qualifying income
5		level. If the department provides verification of a
6		purchaser's actual income, the county shall issue to
7		the department the number of credits corresponding to
8		units or lots sold to purchasers with the same income
9		level under the county's affordable housing programs;
10		<u>and</u>
11	(4)	The chair of the Hawaiian homes commission may certify
12		the income level of a purchaser through written
13		affidavit without reference to the identity or other
14		personal information of the individual purchaser,
15		which shall constitute verification of income for
16		purposes of this section.
17	The credi	ts shall be <u>freely</u> transferable [and shall be issued on
18	a one uni	t for one-unit basis]. The credits may be applied
19	county-wi	de within the same county in which the credits were
20	earned to	satisfy affordable housing obligations imposed by the
21	county on	market priced residential and non-residential
22	developmen	nts. County-wide or project-specific requirements for
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- 1 the location of affordable housing units; housing class, use, or
- 2 type; construction time; or other county requirements for
- 3 affordable housing units shall not impair, restrict, or
- 4 condition the county's obligation to apply the credits in full
- 5 satisfaction of all county requirements.
- 6 Credits originally issued to the department of Hawaiian
- 7 home lands under this section shall not be subject to any county
- 8 restrictions regarding the application of credits toward
- 9 affordable housing obligations, whether by rule, ordinance, or
- 10 particular zoning conditions of a project, including
- 11 restrictions on the location in which the credits may be used,
- 12 the types of required affordable units that may be offset with
- 13 the credits, the income groups that were intended to be served
- 14 by the required housing units, or the timing of the affordable
- 15 housing requirements.
- 16 For purposes of this section, "affordable housing
- 17 obligation" means the requirement imposed by a county to develop
- 18 vacant lots, single-family residences, multi-family residences,
- 19 or any other type of residence for sale or rent to individuals
- 20 within a specified income range."
- 21 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

Report Title:

Affordable Housing Credits; Department of Hawaiian Home Lands; Counties

Description:

Amends section 46-15.1(b), HRS, to clarify that affordable housing credits shall be issued for each single-family residence, multi-family unit, other residential unit, or if allowed under the county's affordable housing programs, vacant lot, developed by the department of Hawaiian home lands under specified conditions and requirements and shall be freely transferrable. Prohibits county limitations relating to application of the credits. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

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
