6	unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.		
7	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective		
8	capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be		
9	expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:		
10	(1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 8 shall be		
11	expended by the department of education;		
12	(2) The sum appropriated in item 9 shall be expended by		
13	the department of transportation; and		
14	(3) The sum appropriated in item 10 shall be expended by		
15	the department of human services.
