## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN FISHPONDS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 183B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"§183B- East Honolulu fishpond heritage area; established. (a) The department of land and natural resources

shall establish the east Honolulu fishpond heritage area to:

(1) Preserve cultural and historical sites, including traditional rock walls, fishpond gates, and auwai;

(2) Preserve and protect native Hawaiian fish, plants, and endangered birds that inhabit the area;

(3) Protect spring water sources, on the surface and underground, from harmful alterations or development;

(4) Provide a site for future public interpretation of the cultural, biological, and historical areas at the fishponds; and

(5) Provide for the reconstruction, rehabilitation, improvement, and stocking of the fishponds, subject to section 171-28.



1        (b) The department of land and natural resources shall  
2 consult as necessary with appropriate federal, state, and county  
3 agencies and community members to implement this section.

4        (c) For purposes of this section, "east Honolulu fishpond  
5 heritage area" encompasses:

6        (1) The Kalauhaihai fishpond, identified by tax map key  
7 numbers 3-7-002:018 and 3-7-002-77;


8        (2) The state-owned portion of Kanewai fishpond,  
9 identified by tax map key number 3-8-002-030; and

10       (3) The land identified by tax map key number 3-8-002-  
11 027."

12       SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
