A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 323F-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b)	The members of the corporation board shall be
4	appointed	as follows:
5	(1)	The director of health as an ex-officio, voting
6		member;
7	(2)	The five regional chief executive officers as ex-
8		officio, voting members;
9	(3)	Two members who reside in the county of Maui who shall
10		be appointed by the Maui regional system board;
1	(4)	One member who resides in the eastern section of the
12		county of Hawaii who shall be appointed by the East
13		Hawaii regional system board;
14	(5)	One member who resides in the western section of the
15		county of Hawaii who shall be appointed by the West
l 6		Hawaii regional system board;
l 7	(6)	One member who resides on the island of Kauai who
18		shall be appointed by the Kauai regional system board;
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1	(7) One member who resides on the Island of Janu who shall			
2	be appointed by the Oahu regional system board; and			
3	(8) One member who shall be appointed by the governor and			
4	serve as an at-large voting member.			
5	The appointed board members [who reside in the county of			
6	Maui, eastern section of the county of Hawaii, western section			
7	of the county of Hawaii, on the island of Kauai, and on the			
8	island of Oahu] shall each serve for a term of four years;			
9	provided that the terms of the initial appointments shall be as			
10	follows: one of the initial members from the county of Maui			
11	shall be appointed to serve a term of two years and the other			
12	member shall be appointed to serve a term of four years; the			
13	initial member from East Hawaii shall be appointed to serve a			
14	term of two years; the initial member from West Hawaii shall be			
15	appointed to serve a term of four years; the initial member from			
16	the island of Kauai shall be appointed to serve a term of two			
17	years; and the initial member from the island of Oahu shall be			
18	appointed to serve a term of four years. [The at large member			
19	appointed by the governor shall serve a term of two years.]			
20	Any vacancy shall be filled in the same manner provided for			
21	the original appointments. The corporation board shall elect			
22	its own chair from among its members. Appointments to the			
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1	corporation board sharr be as representative as possible of the
2	system's stakeholders as outlined in this subsection."
3	SECTION 2. Section 323F-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
5	"(c) Each regional system shall be governed by a regional
6	system board of directors to consist of not less than seven
7	members and not more than fifteen members, as determined by the
8	regional system board after the initial regional system board is
9	established.
10	(1) Each regional system board shall initially consist of
11	twelve members to be appointed by the governor under
12	section 26-34 or as provided in this section, as
13	follows:
14	(A) Four members shall be appointed by the governor
15	within thirty days of receipt of a qualified list
16	of candidates as follows:
17	(i) Two members shall be chosen from a list of
18	four individuals submitted by the speaker of
19	the house of representatives within fifteen
20	days of July 1, 2007; provided that this

list shall not include physicians; and

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1		(11) Two members sharr be chosen from a fist of
2		four individuals submitted by the president
3		of the senate within fifteen days of July 1,
4		2007; provided that this list shall not
5		include physicians;
6	(B)	Four members shall be appointed by the governor
7		within thirty days from a list of eight
8		individuals nominated by the regional public
9		health facility management advisory committee
10		within fifteen days of July 1, 2007. These
11		individuals may be medical and health care
12		providers and professionals, consumers, and
13		knowledgeable individuals in other appropriate
14		areas such as business, finance, and law;
15		provided that these individuals shall not be
16		physicians currently in active practice;
17	(C)	Three physicians shall be appointed by the
18		governor within thirty days from a list submitted
19		within fifteen days of July 1, 2007, of six
20		physicians nominated by a majority vote of the
21		medical staff of the public health facilities in
22		the regional system present at a duly noticed

1		meeting from a list of qualified candidates
2		submitted by the medical executive committees in
3		the regional system; and
4		(D) The corporation board chairperson or
5		chairperson's designee shall serve as an ex
6		officio, nonvoting member of each regional system
7		board;
8	(2)	One member of each regional system board nominated by
9		the speaker of the house of representatives, the
10		president of the senate, and medical executive
11		committees in a regional system shall be appointed for
12		a term of two years;
13	(3)	One member of each initial regional system board
14		nominated by the regional public health facility
15		management advisory committee for the regional system
16		shall be appointed for a term of two years;
17	(4)	The remaining members of each initial regional system
18		board and all members appointed thereafter shall be
19		appointed for terms [of three] between two and five
20		years[+], with the specific term length to be
21		established at the time of appointment by a two-thirds

2]	members; and
3	(5)	New regional system board members appointed to any
4	:	regional system board after the initial regional
5	;	system board shall be selected by a two-thirds

8	Except for	the ex officio members of each regional system board,
9	all other n	members of a regional system board shall be residents
10	of the reg	ion. Each regional system board shall elect its own
11	chair."
