A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AQUATIC LIFE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I.
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this part is to require the
3	establishment of two marine life conservation districts for the
4	island of Maui.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 190, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
7	designated and to read as follows:
8	"§190-A Conservation districts established; island of
9	Maui. In addition to marine life conservation districts as
10	established by the department of land and natural resources
11	pursuant to section 190-2, including marine life conservation
12	districts on the island of Maui at Honolua-Mokuleia Bay and
13	Molokini Shoal, the department of land and natural resources
14	shall establish two additional marine life conservation
15	districts, each one extending three miles or less from the
16	shoreline, as defined in section 205A-1, of the island of Maui
17	into state marine waters.

1	§190-B Conservation districts; reporting requirements. A
2	review of the effectiveness of the marine life conservation
3	districts established pursuant to section 190-A shall be
4	conducted every five years by the department of land and natural
5	resources, in collaboration with the University of Hawaii, and
6	shall be a product of community involvement. The department
7	shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations based
8	on the review to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
9	to the convening of the regular session following the review,
10	beginning with the regular session of 2013."
11	SECTION 3. For purposes of section 190-B, Hawaii Revised
12	Statutes, the review and report shall be a product of community
13	involvement including collaboration among the department of land
14	and natural resources, University of Hawaii, The Humane Society
15	of the United States, Maui Tomorrow, Hui Ho'omalu i ka 'Aina,
16	Pacific Whale Foundation, and other affected or interested
17	parties as determined by the department of land and natural
18	resources.
19	PART II.
20	SECTION 4. The purpose of this part is to statutorily
21	establish the division of aquatic resources under the department
22	of land and natural resources.

- 1 SECTION 5. Section 26-38, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$26-38 Powers and duties of heads of departments. Except 4 as otherwise provided by this chapter, every power and duty 5 conferred by law and required to be performed by any officer, 6 board, department, bureau, commission, administrative agency, or 7 instrumentality of the State existing immediately prior to 8 November 25, 1959, shall hereafter be exercised and performed by 9 the head of the respective department established by this **10** chapter, whether the head of the department be a single 11 executive, board, or commission. 12 Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, the head of a 13 department may assign any function vested in his department to 14 any subordinate officer or employee as he deems desirable. 15 With the approval of the governor, the head of a department may establish or abolish within his department any division or 16 17 other administrative unit to achieve economy and efficiency and 18 in accord with sound administrative principles and practices and 19 procedures [-]; provided that the chairperson of the board of 20 land and natural resources shall not use this authority to 21 abolish or consolidate the division of aquatic resources

2	the administration of his department, for the conduct of its
3	employees, for the performance of its business, and for the
4	custody, use and preservation of records, equipment, and other

7	and 92, or rules promulgated by the governor, or other laws of

9	SECTION 6. Section 187A-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"§187A-4 [Administrator. The board shall appoint an
12	administrator] Division of aquatic resources; administrator.
13	(a) There shall be a division of aquatic resources [who] under
14	the department. The division shall have charge, direction, and
15	control of all matters relating to aquatic resources management,
16	conservation, and development [activities] under this title, and
17	such other matters <u>relating to aquatic resources</u> as the board
18	may direct[-]; except that:
19	(1) The enforcement of laws and rules regulating aquatic
20	resources shall be the responsibility of the
21	conservation and resources enforcement program of

1	chapter 199 instead of the division, unless otherwise
2	directed by the board; and
3	(2) For the purpose of achieving efficiency, the board may
4	provide administrative services for the division of
5	aquatic resources by another division or unit of the
6	department.
7	(b) The division of aquatic resources shall not be placed
8	organizationally under any other division or unit of the
9	department, except the board and office of the chairperson.
10	The division shall not have primary responsibility for a
11	matter unrelated directly and substantially to aquatic resources
12	management, development, or conservation.
13	(c) The division shall be headed by an administrator, who
14	shall be trained and educated in natural resource management."
15	PART III.
16	SECTION 7. In codifying the new sections added by section
17	2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
18	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
19	the new sections in this Act.
20	SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
21	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
22	SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
