A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR CARRIERS.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that motor carriers,
2	including trucking and tour bus companies, are often required to
3	sign transportation service contracts or agreements requiring
4	them to indemnify the other party to the motor carrier
5	transportation services contract for acts of negligence or
6	intentional acts or omissions, regardless of who is actually at
7	fault.
8	Although unfair and onerous, motor carriers often agree to
9	indemnify the other party to secure work. Many motor carriers
10	are small, locally owned businesses that cannot afford to shun
11	service agreements requiring indemnification. These businesses
12	typically lack the leverage to negotiate these indemnification
13	provisions out of contracts.
14	While motor carriers should be held responsible for
15	liability to the extent that the carrier is at fault,
16	indemnification provisions can be unreasonable conditions of a

transportation services agreement that carriers are often unable

to refuse. In addition, indemnification provisions may

- 1 eliminate the incentive for the other party to take precautions
- 2 at their facilities to protect the persons and property being
- 3 transported.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit any portion of a
- 5 motor carrier transportation services contract or agreement that
- 6 requires the carrier to indemnify, defend, or hold harmless the
- 7 other party from any liability for that party's negligence or
- 8 intentional acts or omissions.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 271, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 11 and to read as follows:
- 12 "§271- Motor carrier indemnification agreements
- 13 prohibited. (a) Any provision in a transportation services
- 14 contract or agreement that requires a motor carrier to
- 15 indemnify, defend, or hold harmless or that purports to
- 16 indemnify, defend, or hold harmless, whether in whole or in
- 17 part, the indemnitee under the contract or agreement from any
- 18 claim or liability arising from the negligence or intentional
- 19 acts or omissions of the indemnitee, shall be deemed void and
- 20 unenforceable as a matter of law to the extent that the
- 21 provision seeks to indemnify, defend, or hold harmless the

3	(b) For purposes of this section:											
4	"Indemnitee" means a person who:											
5	(1) Enters into a transportation services contract or											
6	agreement to use the services of a motor carrier, or											
7	to permit a motor carrier to enter the person's											
8	premises; and											
9	(2) In the contract or agreement, is being, or has the											
10	effect of being indemnified, defended, or held											
11	harmless from claims or liabilities for that person's											
12	negligence or intentional acts or omissions.											
13	"Indemnitee" includes an agent, employee, servant, or											
14	independent contractor of the person described in paragraphs (1)											
15	and (2) of this definition.											
16	"Motor carrier" includes an agent, employee, servant, or											
17	independent contractor of the motor carrier.											
18	"Transportation services" means:											
19	(1) The transportation of persons or property;											
20	(2) Entry upon property to load, unload, or transport											
21	persons or property; or
