SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT HONOKAWAI, LAHAINA, MAUI, FOR SEAWALL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the original seawall fronting the Hale Kai Condominium complex was constructed in 1965, prior to the development of the Hale Kai Condominium, and was built to provide necessary coastal protection for the property identified as tax map key: (2) 4-4-001:042; and

WHEREAS, it was later determined that a portion of the seawall encumbers 1,484 square feet of state land, with submerged portions; and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2010, a final environmental assessment for the existing seawall was completed and the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands issued a finding of no significant impact; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2010, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved a Conservation District Use Application for the Association of Unit Owners of the Hale Kai Condominium, for seawall improvements located on state-owned lands, seaward of tax map key: (2) 4-4-001:042; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2011, under agenda item D-2, the Board of Land and Natural Resources granted a fifty-five year term, non-exclusive easement to the Association of Unit Owners of Hale Kai Condominium for seawall purposes, subject to certain terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state submerged lands; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2012, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Land and Natural Resources is authorized to issue a term, non-exclusive easement covering a portion of state submerged lands fronting the property identified as tax map key: (2) 4-4-001:042, at Honokawai, Lahaina, Maui, for the use, maintenance, repair, and removal of an existing seawall over, under, and across stateowned land pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources.
