SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE REGULATION OF BODY PIERCING.

1 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. (2012) proposes to regulate body piercing, that is presently unregulated; 2 3 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that body piercing has 4 become very popular in the United States since the 1990s; and 5 6 WHEREAS, various areas of the body are subject to piercing, 7 such as the ears, tongue, nose, navel, and eyebrows; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, body piercing can be associated with health problems such as infection, allergies to the type of jewelry 12 'used, nerve damage, tetanus, and tearing of the skin; and 13 WHEREAS, body piercing, if sterile techniques are not used, 14 also carries a risk of spreading potentially life-threatening 15 diseases such as hepatitis B or hepatitis C, or tuberculosis; 16 17 and 18 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 19 requires body piercers to be licensed by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs; and 20 21 would require body piercers to 22 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. perform body piercing only in permitted shops or other 23 locations; and 24 25 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires 26 the Auditor to review proposals to regulate professions, 27 vocations, or occupations that are currently unregulated and to 28 assess alternative forms of regulation; now, therefore, 29 30 31 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth

Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2012, the

House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is

respectfully requested to conduct a sunrise review of the regulation of body piercers as proposed under Senate Bill No., including an assessment of alternative forms of regulation, pursuant to section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
