SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY TO APPLY FOR A CHOICE
NEIGHBORHOODS GRANT.

1 WHEREAS, many public housing projects owned and operated by
2 the Hawaii Public Housing Authority ("Authority") are in poor
3 physical condition and require repairs and modernization; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the Authority has reported that as many as four
6 hundred to six hundred units cannot be rented out due to
7 uninhabitable conditions; and
8

9 WHEREAS, during the 2010 federal inspections, eleven out of
10 the sixty-five federal public housing projects failed to pass,
11 receiving a score of fifty-nine or below out of a possible one
12 hundred, and approximately one-third of the Authority's federal
13 public housing projects received a score of sixty-nine or below;

16 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban
17 Development's ("HUD") Choice Neighborhoods Grant Program
18 transforms distressed neighborhoods and public and assisted
19 projects into viable and sustainable mixed-income neighborhoods
20 by linking housing improvements with appropriate services,
21 schools, public assets, transportation, and access to jobs; and

23 WHEREAS, a notice of funding availability for the Choice
24 Neighborhoods Grant Program was announced by HUD in January, and
25 the Authority is an eligible applicant; now, therefore,


27 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth
28 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2012,
29 that the Hawaii Public Housing Authority is urged to apply for a
30 Choice Neighborhoods Grant; and
