## SENATE RESOLUTION

---

URGING THE STATE TO EXPAND THE SCOPE OF THE COMPREHENSIVE  
INFORMATION SYSTEM ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO ACT 54, SESSION  
LAWS OF HAWAII 2011, TO FURTHER INCLUDE PUBLIC FACILITIES,  
THEREBY CREATING A COMPREHENSIVE ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM  
FOR PUBLIC LANDS AND PUBLIC FACILITIES.

1 WHEREAS, Act 54, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, establishes a  
2 comprehensive information system for public lands to be used for  
3 the inventory and maintenance of information relating to the  
4 public land trust, also known as ceded lands, and other state  
5 lands; and  
6

7 WHEREAS, the land inventory required to be taken and  
8 information to be maintained will be important tools to assist  
9 the State to manage its public lands; and  
10

11 WHEREAS, all state and county agencies are directed to  
12 assist the Department of Land and Natural Resources  
13 ("Department") in facilitating the establishment of the  
14 comprehensive information system for public lands; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, the Department shall also determine what other  
17 information would be useful to include in the inventory; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, insufficient information on underutilized land and  
20 public facilities is exacerbating a loss of revenues for the  
21 State; and

23 WHEREAS, given the dire economic situation of the State, it  
24 is important that all state and county agencies work together to  
25 ensure that our lands and facilities are being used to its  
26 fullest potential; now, therefore,

28 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth  
29 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2012,  
30 that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is urged to  
31 expand the scope of the comprehensive information system  
32 established pursuant to Act 54, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, to  
33 inventory and maintain information about the lands of the public



1 land trust described in section 5(f) of the Admission Act and  
2 article XII, section 4, of the Hawaii State Constitution to  
3 further include public facilities, thereby creating a  
4 comprehensive asset management system for public lands and  
5 facilities; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this  
8 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of  
9 Land and Natural Resources.
