& Environmental Protection, to which was referred H.B. No. 1813
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SPECIAL MANAGEMENT AREAS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to exempt capital improvement
projects funded by state or county funds located on state or
county land from special management area guidelines and
requirements.

The Department of Land and Natural Resources, Department of
Transportation, Land Use Research Foundation of Hawaii, and
General Contractors Association of Hawaii testified in support of
this measure. The Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii and Building
Industry Association of Hawaii testified in support of the intent
of this measure. The Office of Planning, Office of Hawaiian
Affairs, Hawaii Americans for Democratic Action, Life of the Land,
The Outdoor Circle, Marine and Coastal Zone Advocacy Council,
Hawaii Chapter of the Sierra Club, and ten individuals testified
in opposition to this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by extending the
exemption of capital improvement projects funded by state or
county funds located on state or county land to apply to
structures to be located within a shoreline area.


Technical, nonsubstantive amendments were made for clarity, consistency, and style.


