- (2) Appropriates funds to enable the Public Utilities Commission to determine and implement utility and regulatory best practices, including hiring consultants; and
- (2) Provides the Public Utilities Commission with the authority to authorize preferential water carrier service rates by tariff for ratepayers engaged in agricultural activities.
