The purpose of this measure is to request the Auditor to:

- Conduct an impact assessment report pursuant to sections (1)23-51 and 23-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, on the social and financial effects of mandating health insurance coverage for fertility preservation procedures for persons who are of reproductive age and have been diagnosed with cancer and will undergo treatment that may adversely affect the person's fertility as described under H.B. No. 2105 (Regular Session of 2012); and
- (2) Submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the Legislature at least 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2013.
