The purpose and intent of this measure is to make a grant-inaid appropriation to the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Hawaii for the career criminal prosecution program.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Honolulu Prosecuting Attorney, Hawaii County Prosecuting Attorney, Hawaii Police Department, and one individual.

Your Committee finds that the career criminal prosecution program was created because a disproportionate amount of serious crimes were committed by a relatively small number of multiple and repeat felony offenders, commonly known as career criminals. response, the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Hawaii created the career criminal prosecution unit. Your Committee further finds that money spent on this unit is an efficient use of resources that provides our citizens with swift and effective justice and reduces heavy caseloads and long court delays.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety, Government Operations, and Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2898 and recommends
