NATIONAL WOMEN'S HISTORY MUSEUM TO SECURE A PERMANENT HOME IN
THE NATION'S CAPITAL,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to request Hawaii's
Congressional delegation to support the efforts of the National
Women's History Museum to secure a permanent home in Washington,
D.C., for a museum that will highlight the important role women
have played in shaping the United States.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure
from one individual.

Your Committees find that there are numerous museums
dedicated to various issues and people of interest in Washington,
D.C., but no national museum exists that is dedicated solely to
women's history. Establishing a presence near the National Mall
in the nation's capital would ensure that women's sacrifices and
contributions throughout America's history remain visible and
relevant to our younger generations. This measure requests
Hawaii's Congressional delegation to support the efforts of the
National Women's History Museum to secure a permanent home in
Washington, D.C., for a museum that will highlight the important
role women have played in shaping the nation.


