SB 2341, SD2 (SSCR2675) Status

RELATING TO LAND USE.

Repeals the prohibition on agricultural tourism activities in the absence of a bona fide farming operation. Repeals the prohibition on ordinances that allow overnight accommodations in agricultural

districts. Authorizes agricultural tourism activities, including overnight accommodations of twenty-one days or less, for any one stay within a county; provided that a county has adopted ordinances

regulating agricultural tourism. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

SB 2375, SD3 (SSCR2466)

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL-BASED COMMERCIAL OPERATIONS.

AGR/ERB, WLO

AGR/ERB, WLO

Status

Defines agricultural-based commercial operations and authorizes agricultural-based commercial operations in agricultural districts. Includes agricultural-based commercial operations under the definition of "farming operation" in chapter 165, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Takes

effect 7/1/2050. (SD3)

SB 2460 (SSCR2551) Status

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

AGR, FIN

Allows moneys in the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund to be expended for the electronic importer manifest program. Makes an appropriation for the implementation of the electronic importer

manifest program. Effective July 1, 2012.



SB 2695, SD2 (SSCR2576) Status

RELATING TO LIVESTOCK FEED.

AGR, FIN

Creates a livestock feed feasibility pilot project to investigate the viability of growing and processing livestock feed on land held by the department of agriculture. Appropriation. (SD2)
