RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYER ORGANIZATIONS.

Status & Testimony

Adds powers and duties to the director of labor and industrial relations regarding the registration and regulation of professional employer organizations. Authorizes various penalties for noncompliance with chapter 373L, HRS. Establishes the professional employer special fund to manage the registration of professional employer organizations. Amends certain definitions in chapter 373L, HRS, to make them consistent with definitions in chapter 373K, HRS.

RELATING TO UNCLAIMED PROPERTY.

Requires holders of unclaimed property to remit all property with their November 1 report and corrects references to the

Unclaimed Property Trust Fund.

SB 2632

RELATING TO FEE TIME SHARE INTERESTS.

CPN/JDL, WAM

Status & Testimony

Permits all fee time share interests to be recorded in the regular system rather than the land court. Removes requirement that land court update certificates of title for individual fee time share interests as a condition to deregistration. Allows bureau of conveyances to charge a fee for each recording in the bureau of conveyances and in the office of the assistant registrar of the land court for services rendered by the bureau of conveyances for two years.
