SB 2482 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDU/EDT, WAM

Status & Testimony

Establishes the Hawaii public schools science and technology trust fund to support the teaching and learning of science and technology in Hawaii's public schools. Authorizes income tax

return designations to the trust fund.

SB 2528 RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY. EDU/EDT, WAM

Status & Testimony

Places the Hawaii 3Ts school technology laboratories fund under the department of business, economic development, and tourism. Repeals section 302A-1314, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

SB 2990 RELATING TO ALOHA STADIUM. EDT/EDU, WAM

Status & Testimony

Requires the University of Hawaii to hire an independent third party to conduct a feasibility study to determine the effects of placing Aloha Stadium under the jurisdiction of the University of Hawaii rather than the department of accounting and general

services. Makes an appropriation.

SB 2991 RELATING TO ALOHA STADIUM. EDT/EDU, WAM

Status & Testimony

Requires the stadium authority to pay the University of Hawaii twenty-five per cent of all revenues the University of Hawaii generates at Aloha Stadium. Authorizes payment of the distribution to the University of Hawaii out of the stadium special

fund.

SB 2992 RELATING TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY. EDT/EDU

Amends section 109-1(a), HRS, to make the president of the University of Hawaii, or the president's designee, a voting member of the stadium authority. Clarifies the total membership of the authority by including ex officio members in the member

count.
