SB 656, SD1 (SSCR54) Status	RELATING TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION. Requires the public utilities commission to publish contracts, including price information, for the purchase of renewable energy by energy utilities on a publicly-accessible portion of the commission's website. (SD1)	EEP, CPC/JUD, FIN
SB 2981, SD2 (SSCR2679) Status	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Allows the public utilities commission to direct electric utilities to develop or consider specific scenarios and resource options as part of their integrated resource plans. (SD2)	EEP, CPC, FIN
