**SB 2038** RELATING TO ENERGY RESOURCES. ENE, WLH

Requires solar water heaters on new duplex buildings and Status & allows for a variance by an occupant. Testimony

**SB 2823** RELATING TO SOLID WASTE. ENE, WAM

Increases the solid waste management surcharge to \$1.25 per Status & ton of solid waste disposed of in landfills or shipped out-of-state; **Testimony** 

increases the solid waste management surcharge to 60 cents per ton of solid waste disposed of at waste-to-energy facilities that accept 150,000 tons or more of solid waste annually; provides for no surcharges to waste-to-energy facilities that accept less than 150,000 tons of solid waste annually and for ash disposed of in landfills that originates from a waste-to-

energy facility, and defines "waste-to-energy facility".

**SB 2822** RELATING TO RECYCLING. ENE, WAM

Creates a recycling program for all electrically powered Status & consumer devices, creates the Electric Device Recycling Testimony

Special Fund, and abolishes the Electronic Device Recycling

Fund.
