## **DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):**

SB2038 RELATING TO ENERGY RESOURCES. ENE, WLH

Status and Testimony Requires solar water heaters on new duplex buildings and allows

for a variance by an occupant.

SB2823 RELATING TO SOLID WASTE. ENE, WAM

Status and Testimony Increases the solid waste management surcharge to \$1.25 per ton

of solid waste disposed of in landfills or shipped out-of-state; increases the solid waste management surcharge to 60 cents per ton of solid waste disposed of at waste-to-energy facilities that accept 150,000 tons or more of solid waste annually; provides for no surcharges to waste-to-energy facilities that accept less than 150,000 tons of solid waste annually and for ash disposed of in landfills that originates from a waste-to-energy facility, and defines

"waste-to-energy facility".

SB2822 RELATING TO RECYCLING. ENE, WAM

Status and Testimony Creates a recycling program for all electrically powered consumer

devices, creates the Electric Device Recycling Special Fund, and

abolishes the Electronic Device Recycling Fund.

No testimony will be accepted.
