SB 2473 RELATING TO HEALTH. HTH/CPN, JDL

Status & Testimony

Prohibits the sale, distribution, or procurement of products or packaging containing certain toxic chemicals. Establishes a preference for the procurement of polyvinyl chloride-free intravenous products by the Hawaii health systems corporation.

SB 2603 RELATING TO INSURANCE. HTH/CPN, WAM

Status & Testimony

Mandates health insurance coverage for the diagnosis and treatment of autism spectrum disorders under accident and health or sickness insurance and group hospital and medical services contracts and health maintenance organizations.

SB 2631 RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE. HTH/CPN, WAM

Status & Requires health insurers, mutual benefit societies, and health maintenance organizations to provide health care coverage and

benefits for autism spectrum disorders beginning after

12/31/2012.
