Testimony

Defines the consumer in the health insurance exchange board.

Clarifies that the health insurance exchange board shall have geographic diversity consisting of representation from all islands. Removes health plans from the board. Requires the

health insurance exchange to offer a basic health plan.

SB 2100 RELATING TO ASSAULT ON MEDICAL SERVICES HTH, JDL

PROVIDERS.

Status & Amends the offense of assault in the second degree to include

intentionally or knowingly causing bodily injury to certain medical

services providers.

SB 2145 RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH. HTH, WAM

Status & Requires the adult mental health division of the department of health to provide services to people with a qualifying diagnosis.

Allows the department of health to bill and receive

reimbursement from an insurer for treatment services rendered

Allows pharmacists, per a physician's prescription, to administer the influenza vaccine to persons aged fourteen to seventeen provided that the pharmacist has fulfilled certain requirements.
